Sub: -FIR against theft of electricity.

I, the undersigned, do hereby lodge a complaint being empowered by the Electricity Act 2003 and its amendment act 2007 against 1) Dilip Ghosh, S/O-Late Panchanan Ghosh, 2) Nimai Ghosh, S/O- Lt. Brajendra Ghosh & 3) Asis Ghosh, S/O- Lt. Brajendra Ghosh all of Village-Bhatuigeria, P.O-Sahaspur, P.S- Anandapur Dist-Paschim Medinipur for committing theft of electricity U/S-135(1)(a), 135(1)(a) and 135(1)(b) respectively of Electricity Act 2003 and its amendment act 2007 as stated hereunder.

Today on 22.10.2019 at 14:30 hrs I, Sri Rabindranath Jana, Station Manager of Anandapur CCC, S/O- Lt. Sagar Chandra Jana along with Sri Tathagata Mukherjee, J.E. Grade -II(E), S/O- Shekhar Mukherjee, Sri Arup Kumar Singha, LM, S/O-Murali Mohan Singha, Sri Kousik Das, Senior TSH, S/O- Late Rabindranath Das, Sri Kalyan Kumar Roy, TSH, S/O- Late Kirtiban Roy, Sri Trilochan Bagdi S/O-Late Baul Bagdi, Hg. Sr. TSH, Sri Tanay Kr. Halder, S/O- Late Tushar Kr Halder and other technical staffs of Anandapur CCC entered into the domestic premises of Dilip Ghosh and inspected his domestic premises and properties of WBSEDCL.

During inspection it was found that Dilip Ghosh, S/O-Late Panchanan Ghosh of Village-Bhatuigeria, P.O-Sahaspur, P.S- Anandapur Dist-Paschim Medinipur was consuming electricity dishonestly and unauthorizedly by way of direct hooking with the help of 2 nos. yellow coloured 7/16 SWG PVC covered aluminum cable from nearest LTOH line connected to his house for running different electrical appliances thus causing WBSEDCL huge amount of revenue loss. Upon detection of theft we disconnected the hooking line and collected some portion of 2 nos. yellow coloured 7/16 SWG PVC covered aluminum cable approx. length 09 feet along with hooking arrangement as sample. We packed, labeled and sealed the seized article at the spot. In spite of request the local witnesses and the representative of the accused person refused to sign in the inspection sheet, seizure list and label. We left the premises at 14:50 hrs. after completion of all the formalities.

Then at 14.55 hrs we held inspection in the domestic premises of Nimai Ghosh, S/O- Lt. Brajendra Ghosh. During inspection it was found that Nimai Ghosh was consuming electricity dishonestly and unauthorizedly by way of direct hooking with the help of 2 nos red coloured 7/23SWG PVC covered aluminum cable from nearest LTOH line connected to his house for running different electrical appliances thus causing WBSEDCL huge amount of revenue loss. Upon detection of theft we disconnected the hooking line and collected some portion of 2 nos red coloured 7/23SWG PVC covered aluminum cable approx. length 09 feet along with hooking arrangement as sample. We packed, labeled and sealed the seized article at the spot. In spite of request the local witnesses and the representative of the accused person refused to sign in the inspection sheet, seizure list and label. We left the premises at 15.20 hrs. after completion of all the formalities.

Then at 15.25 hrs. we held inspection in the domestic premises of) Asis Ghosh, S/O- Lt. Brajendra Ghosh. During inspection it was found that Asis Ghosh was consuming electricity dishonestly and unauthorizedly by way of bypassing his existing energy meter (Meter No:-TA075304) with the help of 2 nos. one black and one faded yellow coloured PVC covered aluminum cable from nearest LTOH line connected to his house for running different electrical appliances thus causing WBSEDCL huge amount of revenue loss. Upon detection of theft we disconnected the hooking line and collected some portion of 2 nos. one black and one faded yellow coloured PVC covered aluminum cable approx. length 09 feet along with hooking arrangement as sample. We packed, labeled and sealed the seized article at the spot. In spite of request the local witnesses and the representative of the accused person refused to sign in the inspection sheet, seizure list and label. We left the premises at 15:45 hrs. after completion of all the formalities.
