Sir, In producing herewith the arrested charged person namely Kartick Dalbera (54 Yrs) S/O-Lt Ganendra Dalbera of Vill-Paruliya, PS-Anandapur, Dist-Paschim Medinipur along with seized articles as per seizure list, I, SI Debasis Dutta of Anandapur PS lodged this complaint against the aforesaid person as suo-moto to the effect that today (25.05.2022) at 16:45 hrs during my Special raid duty vide C C No. 1307/22 dt: 25.05.2022 & GDE No. 997 dt: 25.05.2022 along with NVF 2425 Indrajit Das, NVF-0937 Sanjay Raj, NVF-0235 Goutam Duley all of Anandapur PS, received telephonic information from one of my reliable source that Kartick Dalbera (54 Yrs) S/O-Lt Ganendra Dalbera of Vill-Paruliya, PS-Anandapur, Dist-Paschim Medinipur store huge quantity of illicit liquor in his Tea Stall at Paruliya for the purpose of sell. Accordingly I informed the matter to the superiors and as per their direction had been to Paruliya village.

At 17:25 hrs myself with my accompanied forces reached at the Tea Stall of said Kartick Dalbera at Paruliya village and seeing the Police party, above noted charged person tried to take to his heel. But, before he could make his safe escape we chased and caught him up. Being asked he disclosed his above identity and confessed that he is the owner of the Tea Stall. On demand he could not produce any valid documents in favour of his illegal business. We searched the Tea Stall of Kartick Dalbera and seized the following articles in presence of local witnesses and the articles were labeled too by taking the signature of witnesses and the charged person at PO. Then I arrested him after observing all formalities as guided by the Apex Court.

The descriptions of the articles as follows -

- (1) 04 (four) sealed bottle each contain 600 ml Country Spirit labeled as Captain.
- (2) 08 (Eight) sealed bottle each contain 300 ml Country Spirit labeled as Mahua 70 up.
- (3) 02 (Two) sealed bottle each contain 750 ml foreign Liquid labeled as Officer Choice.
- (4) 02 (Two) sealed bottle each contain 750 ml foreign Liquid labeled as RUM.
- (5) 01 (One) sealed bottle each contain 375 ml foreign Liquid labeled as RUM.
- (6) 02 (Two) sealed bottle each contain 180 ml foreign Liquid labeled as Officer Choice.

Therefore, I pray a specific Case against the above noted charged person u/s 46 A Bengal Excise Act may kindly be started and arrange for its investigation.
